(CPS) is an individual who has demonstrated competence related to alcohol, tobacco and drug prevention who provides services that build capacities of individual and systems to promote healthy environments, lifestyles and communities.

Requirements

- 120 Hours of pre-approved coursework
- Two years full time experience in prevention.
- Successful completion of the ICRC prevention written exam.

Cape Assist offers a one-year program that allows the student to complete all 120 hours of course work needed to be eligible to take the final CPS exam. The twenty classes necessary to complete the course work are offered at Cape Assists office in Wildwood NJ.
