A **FREE** four-day in-person 30-hour course. Life Space Crisis Intervention (LSCI) is a brain based, trauma informed, relationship-building verbal strategy that helps adults turn problem situations into learning opportunities for young people who exhibit challenging behaviors in schools and communities. LSCI is centered on the core belief that behavioral changes for our most difficult children and youth start with the adults.

Who should attend: Individuals from a building or district that are responsible for assisting with behavioral or emotional support. This is not designed to be implemented in a classroom setting.
